

EIGHT STEPS TO BECOMING ESA CERTIFIED



1

Review your current QA program or decide if QA certification is required for your market.

2

Review ESA documentation to see if it meets your requirements.

3

Decide whether to proceed with ESA and **register your business** with AUS-MEAT.

5

Contact one of the four Certification Bodies to schedule your initial certification audit:

- AUS-QUAL
- BSI Group ANZ
- Merieux NutriSciences
- SGS Australia

4

Get your farm ready for audit by ensuring all systems and records are in place. For an overview of requirements consult the Interpretation Guidelines or the standard's checklist in the Aus Eggs app.

6

Participate in your initial audit and resolve any outstanding issues.

7

Receive your ESA certificate which is valid for 12 months. This should take 10 working days.

8

Schedule your next audit to take place before 12 months is up so your certification stays current!
